

Dutch Nationals in the Netherlands

WELCOME TO WAGENINGEN UNIVERSITY

Admitted..... what's the next step?

Dutch nationals still have to do a few things before they can start at Wageningen University. The most important is to register as a student at Wageningen University. It is important to arrange registration well in time. If you leave everything to the last minute, it could well be that your registration is not processed before September 1.

Wageningen University will send the University Registration Forms to students at their home address at the beginning of June (those students who have been admitted to the Master programme before June 1). For those admitted to the programme after June 1, the forms are sent on a regular basis. If the registration set has not been received within 2 weeks of being admitted, please send an [email](#).

Do **not** return the conformation form to the Student Service Centre, this form is intended for international students.

How can I register when I'm not in the Netherlands?

You can request a registration set and complete it before you leave the country or you can authorize your parents, in writing, to complete and sign your registration form for you. As previously mentioned, it is in your own interest to arrange your registration well in time. And ... make sure that you are back in time for the Introduction Days.

I have been admitted to the linkage programme, what does that mean?

The linkage programme means that your pre-education does not match 100% with the admission criteria for the Master. You will have to take some courses in the Bachelor before you can start with the Master programme. Please [contact the study advisor](#)

Housing

You can contact [IDEALIS](#) (Studenten Huisvesting) if student accommodation is required. Students with the Dutch nationality residing **outside** the Netherlands can contact [International Student Support](#) if assistance is required with student accommodation.

Idealis is the largest student housing cooperation in Wageningen. Idealis has 4 large student buildings in the "outskirts" of Wageningen and buildings in the centre of Wageningen. When you sign the tenancy agreement at Idealis, you will have to pay the first month's rent, The rent will be between €260,00 and €330,00 per month, this includes heating, electricity, water, internet and a minimum maintenance fee and is due before the first day of the month.

EDUweb

When your registration form has been processed, you will receive a username and password for your WUR account by email. You require a WUR account to be able to log in to EDUweb. EDUweb is the gateway on the internet to your education at Wageningen University. On EDUweb you will find:

- Messages from your lecturers
- Links to sites about the courses you are going to take
- Your most recent marks
- Your lecture timetable
- A list of your courses
- Your details from the library

English language proficiency

The language of instruction at Wageningen University is English and we would like to emphasize that a good command of the English language is essential to be able to participate in the MSc programme. All students are therefore required to take a free English language test (takes approximately 20 minutes) to establish their level of English. The test is mandatory and the programme coordinators also receive the test results. Students can subsequently follow courses depending on their level of English. Costs of the course approximately €90,-. Upon arrival in Wageningen you will receive information concerning this mandatory English language test and the courses offered.

Finally!! The Annual Introduction Days!!

To start your time here well and to let you get to know Wageningen, the student life and your study, there is an introduction week. These Annual Introduction Days (AID) are organized by senior students for all new students at Wageningen University and Van Hall Larenstein. It is highly recommended to follow the introduction programme prior to the start of the academic year. Both Dutch and non-Dutch students will join together and explore the city of Wageningen. The new students will be divided in groups and be guided by 2 senior mentors. It is a wonderful way to start your study!! You'll get to know your fellow students, different associations, sports facilities, University buildings, places to go out and much more. The AID-program has a great variety of things to do and there will be for example a music festival, a sports day, an information market and a street theatre festival. The AID will be concluded with a spectacular closing act after the street theatre festival.
